

The Borealis-MORE Scholarship supports refugees or displaced persons who are completing an academic degree program at the Johannes Kepler University Linz.

## What does taking part in the Borealis-MORE Scholarship mean for you?

- A scholarship amounting € 110 or € 360 per month (depending on your residence status)
- A travel allowance (for those living outside of Linz)
- Covering any incurred tuition fees
- Signing a "Learning Agreement" (and successfully completing 12 ECTS credits per semester)
- Taking part in regularly scheduled get-togethers to share ideas and connect

## Who is eligible to apply for the Borealis-MORE Scholarship?

- Refugees or displaced persons enrolled at the JKU Linz,
- Refugees or displaced persons holding a valid letter of admission\* (= an official letter issued by the JKU stating you may enroll at the JKU as a degree-seeking student, and
- if you are currently not receiving any financial aid (such as a study grant, the Ernst Mach Grant, ...)

## How can you apply?

- Send your application and documents per e-mail to <u>more@jku.at</u> between **June 24**, **2024 and July 7**, **2024 (= application deadline!) (Subject: BO-MO Scholarship)**.
- The application form is available on our homepage jku.at/en/more.
- You will receive a notification containing information about scheduling an interview during July 2024 at the JKU Linz.

## What documents do we need from you?

- A completed and signed application form
- ✓ A current curriculum vitae
- ✓ A Letter of Intent (min. ½ of an A4-size page)
- ✓ A copy of your current residence card and/or identity card
- ✓ Your letter indicating a decision regarding asylum
- ✓ A copy of your JKU letter of admission stating you are eligible to enroll in the degree program of your choice
- ✓ Any acceptance or rejection for a state study grant, such as the Ernst Mach Grant (if available)
- ✓ Any confirmation of employment (if available)
- ✓ A copy of your academic transcripts and study record sheet (KUSSS) from the 2023/2024 academic year

<u>Please note:</u> The Borealis-MORE Scholarship supports JKU students <u>only</u>. To be eligible for the Borealis-MORE Scholarship, you must be currently enrolled at the JKU, or eligible to enroll (= positive letter of admission).
