

MOREclassic supports refugees and displaced persons who study at the Johannes Kepler University Linz.

What does taking part in the MOREclassic mean for you?

- A scholarship to cover tuition fees
- Discount for courses as outlined in the pre-study program, such as German language learning courses
- A travel allowance (for those living outside of Linz)
- Advising services and taking part in regularly scheduled information sessions to share information and to network

Who is eligible to apply for the MOREclassic program?

- Refugees or displaced persons, who
- are already enrolled at the JKU and
 - have received a valid letter of admission (official letter by the JKU you may enroll at the university),
 or
 - o those who are subject to just one or more supplementary examination as part of the pre-study program

How do you apply for MOREclassic?

- Send a completed application and the required documents per e-mail to more@jku.at between June 24, 2024 and July 7, 2024 (= application deadline!) (Subject: MOREclassic application)
- The application form is available on our homepage at: <u>iku.at/en/more</u>.

What documents do we need from you?

- ✓ A completed and signed application form
- ✓ A current curriculum vitae
- ✓ A letter of motivation (min. ½ of an A4-size page)
- ✓ Your current residence card (copy)
- ✓ Your letter of admission issued by the JKU
- ✓ A copy of your JKU-Card (if available)
- ✓ A copy of your most recently issued German language certificate (if available)
- ✓ Any acceptance or rejection for a (state) study grant, such as the Ernst Mach Grant (if available)
- ✓ Any confirmation of employment (if available)
- ✓ Your academic transcripts & study record sheet (KUSSS) from the 2023/2024 academic year

<u>Please note:</u> MOREclassic supports JKU students <u>only</u>. To be eligible for MOREclassic, you must be currently enrolled at the JKU, or eligible to enroll (= positive letter of admission).
