

ERASMUS+ SCHOLARSHIP FOR A TRAINEESHIP/INTERNSHIP

Prerequisites:

- Current active registration in an official study programme at JKU (academic status must remain active for duration of internship) or completion of a degree just prior to the internship
- For Bachelor's and Diploma Degree Programmes:**
 - Min. 2 completed semesters and a minimum of 40 successfully completed ECTS points in field of study relevant for the internship
 - StEOP completed at the JKU or at one of the *Cluster Mitte* institutions (Education)
 - Actively taken exams ("*prüfungsaktiv*") in the preceding two semesters
- For Master's Degree Programme:**
 - Bachelor or Diploma degree has been completed at the JKU and the internship begins in the 1st semester of study: Actively taken exams ("*prüfungsaktiv*") in the preceding two semesters
 - If the Bachelor or Diploma degree was completed at another institution and internship begins in the first semester: at least 8 ECTS points must have been completed
 - Internships starting after the first semester: Actively taken exams ("*prüfungsaktiv*") in the preceding semester (8 ECTS points) / academic year (16 ECTS points) or completed a minimum of 80 ECTS in the Master's
- For Doctoral Degree Programme:**
 - Active employment status at the JKU (or at an affiliated company): structured doctoral program
 - Not actively employed at the JKU: dissertation agreement or in the first two semesters a letter of recommendation from the dissertation supervisor
- Post Graduates:**
 - The selection process for the internship must have taken place prior to the completion of studies
 - Participant must not be enrolled at a higher education institution during the internship
 - The internship must end within 12 calendar months subsequent to the completion of studies/graduation
 - The scholarship period is limited **to 2 months** (remaining time: zero grant period)

Exceptions can be made in justified cases

Furthermore:

- It must be a full-time internship relevant for the study programme at JKU
- The host institution may not be a European Union (EU) agency/institution or an agency/institution financed by the EU.
- Eligible countries: The member states of the EU as well as Iceland, Liechtenstein, Northern Macedonia, Norway, Serbia and Turkey; for MED-KPJ worldwide
- An internship in the home country (centre of life/main residence before studying at JKU) cannot be financially supported
- Complete scholarship application at least 1 month prior to the internship.
- The minimum duration of the internship is 2 months. The maximum duration is 12 months (24 months if during diploma studies) per study level.
The scholarship period is limited to 6 months. If the remuneration exceeds 150% of the scholarship rate, the scholarship period will be limited to 2 months. The remaining time will be a "zero grant" period.
- For students who have children and for students with disabilities: Special funding (EUR 250/month) is available. For costs exceeding EUR 250/month a separate application is needed 3 months before the start of the internship at the latest.
- The host country's entry and stay conditions must be followed.
- There is no legal claim to be awarded a scholarship
